Is there a God? Does it matter?

This is the most important question we have to ask ourselves. Either there is a God who created this universe for a specific purpose, a God who knows each one of us by name and loves us despite ourselves, a God who invites us to become His children and a citizen of His Kingdom, or there is not. God does not exist if we believe in Him and cease to exist if we do not.

I have been a christian now for 61 years and am totally convinced that there is one God and that he has revealed himself to us in Jesus Christ. By the grace of God I am His child and a citizen of His Kingdom guaranteed to share his eternal home forever.

I was not always so sure. I was brought up in a strong christian home and taught the bible from birth. At the age of 12 I put my trust in Jesus Christ and thanked him for dying for me so that I could receive eternal life and became his child. However in my late teens I started to question whether there was a God. Do I just believe this because my parents taught me, or is He real? I like to think deeply and the thought of there not being a God and my being able to be a 'free' agent became increasingly attractive.

I had the opportunity to work on various ships as a Purser for 6 years away from home and church. It was a time I enjoyed very much, but it also gave me the opportunity to examine the question "Is there a God" in great detail. It was the first time I visited the (then) Soviet Union to look at a society that officially banned God. I also looked at other religions, and visited Israel to study the roots of Christianity.

By the end of those 6 years I had come to the absolute conviction that there is a God, and only one, and that He has revealed himself to us in Jesus Christ. I have not had a single doubt since.

The key factor for me was recognising the absolute irrationality of evolution, the blind faith that people must have to believe that this amazing, intricate, complex, wonderful world we live in could happen by random chance when there is no evidence at all of the billions of random mutations that would need to have happened to support evolution.

Having come to that absolute conclusion I enjoy daily the wonder of belonging to God, developing an ever closer relationship with Him, and being totally at peace with Him despite my failures. It has also given an understanding of God's design for our lives and society and how He has given us the answers for this life, and the next. I look forward to enjoying being in His perfect presence forever.

True success is to be at peace with God and all humanity.

Genesis 1 also tells us God made all living things in their own species.

Finally

God created human beings in his own image. In the image of God he created them, male and female He created them.

Genesis 1 v 27

Being made in the (spiritual) image of God sets us apart from all other parts of creation. From God we receive the spiritual dimension to love, create, and live with Him. Only humans have this capacity.

There is no conflict between the big bang theory of scientists and the biblical record – the difference is that the bible tells us who caused it and why it happened.
